

BOARD'S REPORT

To,
The Shareholders,

Your Directors have pleasure in presenting the Seventh (7th) Annual Report together with the Financial Statements of your Company for the period ended March 31, 2025.

1. REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

Chandil Transmission Limited, a wholly owned subsidiary of RECPDCL was incorporated as a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) on March 14, 2018, to undertake activities for development of various elements covered under "Transmission System Strengthening in Jharkhand State, (Package-1)" through tariff based competitive bidding process for selection of the developer for the project. REC Transmission Projects Company Limited (RECTPCL) is wholly owned subsidiary of M/s REC Limited, a Government of India Enterprise has been amalgamated with M/s REC Power Distribution Company Limited (RECPDCL), another wholly owned subsidiary of M/s REC Limited as per MCA order no.24/1/2020-CL-III dated 05.02.2021. Hence, the company, Chandil Transmission Limited has become the wholly owned subsidiary of REC Power Development and Consultancy Limited (RECPDCL).

A two stage Bidding process featuring separate Request for Qualification (RfQ) and Request for Proposal (RfP) has been adopted in accordance with tariff based competitive bidding guidelines of Ministry of Power, GoI for selection of developer as Transmission Service Provider. The RfQ for the project has been issued on February 10, 2018. Due to change in scope of work and after forwarding the preliminary survey report to CMPDI. Uranium Corporation of India Ltd. Vide its letter dated 14.05.2019 has informed that proposed line is passing through the existing leased area of Narwapahar Mines as well as proposed Banadungri & Garadi Uranium project.

JUSNL vide letter dated 30.09.2020 informed RECTPCL {Now, RECPDCL (holding company)} to cancel RfQ and RfP for all 4 Packages 1, 2, 3 & 4 for implementation of transmission projects through TBCB route in Jharkhand against resolution no. 2648 dated 21.08.2017 of Energy Department, Govt. of Jharkhand. Since then bidding process of the all packages was annulled. Accordingly, the company is under process of strike-off.

5. SHARE CAPITAL

The Paid-up share capital of the company as on March 31, 2025 was ₹5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) divided into 50,000 equity shares of ₹10/- each. Therefore, the entire Share Capital of the Company is held by the holding company REC power Development and Consultancy Limited and its nominees.

11. COMMENTS OF THE C&AG OF INDIA

The Comptroller and Auditor General of India, vide letters dated July 21, 2025 have given 'Nil' Comments respectively on the Audited Financial Statements of your Company for the year ended March 31, 2025 under Section 143 (6) (b) of the Companies Act, 2013. The Comments of C&AG for the financial year 2024-25, are placed along with the report of Statutory Auditors of the Company elsewhere in this Annual Report.

12. PERSONNEL

Your Company has not appointed any permanent employees. Some of the employees of main holding company i.e. REC Limited have been assigned the additional duty to carry out the day to day work of REC Power Development and Consultancy Limited, the

holding company of Chandil Transmission Limited. Accordingly, the provisions in respect of Maternity Benefit Act are being complied by the Holding Company. As such the provisions of Maternity Benefit Act is not applicable on the Company as the Company is not having its own manpower.

13. PARTICULARS REGARDING CONSERVATION OF ENERGY, TECHNOLOGY ABSORPTION

There are no significant particulars, relating to conservation of energy, technology absorption under Rule 8(3) of Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014.

14. PARTICULARS REGARDING EXPENDITURE INCURRED ON RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT AND FOREIGN EXCHANGE EARNINGS AND OUTGO

No such expenditure was incurred during the period. Further, no Export initiatives were carried out during the period and the Company has no earning or outgo in foreign exchange as per Rule 8(3) of Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014.

15. DEPOSIT

Your Company has not accepted any public deposit during the period under review.

16. PARTICULARS OF CONTRACTS AND ARRANGEMENTS WITH RELATED PARTIES

The arrangements/ transactions during the period ended March 31, 2025 with related parties were in the ordinary course of business and on an arm's length basis, if any. Disclosures of related party transactions and particulars of contracts or arrangements referred to in Section 188(1) of Companies Act, 2013, in prescribed Form AOC-2 as per Rule 8(2) of Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014, is appended as Annexure to this Board's report.

There is no significant event occurred after Balance Sheet date till the date of Director's Report.

18. RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY

Presently a separate risk management policy for the company has not been developed.

19. DISCLOSURES

- a. There are no instances regarding non- compliance, penalties, strictures imposed on the Company by any statutory authority since incorporation.
- b. The Company is a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) and a wholly owned subsidiary of REC Power Development and Consultancy Limited, subsidiary of REC Limited and accordingly Presidential Directives issued by the Central Government to the extent applicable on the Company are being complied since incorporation.
- c. There is no expenditure debited in Books of accounts, which is not for the purpose of the business. There are no expense incurred which are personal in nature and incurred for the Board of Directors and Top Management.
- d. The Statutory Auditors have issued their report without any adverse remarks/ observations/qualifications. Further, Statutory Auditors have not reported any instances of fraud committed by the Company or against the Company by its officers and employees;

- e. The holding company i.e. REC Power Development and Consultancy Limited bears all the expenditures on behalf of this company along with all other fellow subsidiaries.
- f. The Company has been incorporated as a wholly owned subsidiary of REC Transmission Projects Company Limited (Now RECPDCL) on March 14, 2018 to undertake activities for development of various elements of Transmission System Strengthening in Jharkhand State. A two stage Bidding process featuring separate Request for Qualification (RfQ) and Request for Proposal (RfP) has been adopted in accordance with tariff based competitive bidding guidelines of Ministry of Power, GoI for selection of developer as Transmission Service Provider. The RfQ for the project has been issued on February 10, 2018. Due to change in scope of work and after forwarding the preliminary survey report to CMPDI. - g. No significant and material orders have been passed by the Regulators or Courts or Tribunals which would affect the going concern status and Company's operations in future. However, Company is under process of strike off and NoC from the Ministry of Power is awaited for the same.
- h. There are no loans given, investments made, guarantees given and securities provided by the company as per Section 186 of the Companies Act, 2013 during the period under review.
- i. There is no vigilance case pending as on March 31, 2025;
- j. The Central Government has not prescribed the maintenance of cost records for the products/services of the Company under Companies (Cost -Records and Audit) Rules, 2014, read with Companies (Cost Records and Audit) Amendment Rules, 2014 prescribed by the Central Government under Section 148 of the Companies Act, 2013. Accordingly, Cost Accounts and Records are not required to be maintained by the Company.
- k. The Company is a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) and a wholly owned subsidiary of RECPDCL in terms of the provisions of Companies Act, 2013. However, the company is managed as per the mandate from Government of India (GoI)/ State Governments and RECPDCL does not have the ability to direct the relevant activities of the company unilaterally. RECPDCL therefore, considers its investment in SPV as associates having significant influence.
- l. The provisions relating to Audit Committee is not applicable to the Company;
- m. As on March 31, 2025, there was no application made or proceeding pending against the Company, for initiation of Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016. Further, during the year no such event has arisen that give rise to reporting of details w.r.t. difference between amount of the valuation done at the time of one time settlement and valuation done while taking loan from the Banks or Financial Institutions;
- n. During the year under review the Company has not issued any stock options, equity shares with differentials voting rights and sweat equity shares;
- o. The provisions of Section 197 of the Companies Act, 2013 and Rules made thereunder are not applicable to Government Companies.
