The minimum height of the boundary wall shall be of 1.8 m from finished ground level (FGL).	Security compound using Solid Block Masonry/ Burnt Brick Masonry with steel fabrication and barbed wire fencing shall be constructed around the switchyard area. Article 10.3.1 (a) of TSA	For payment of Invoices through any mode of payment, a Rebate of 2% shall be allowed on the Monthly Transmission Charge Invoice or Supplementary Bill for payments made in full within two Business Day of the receipt of the Invoice; or	For payment of Invoices through letter of credit on presentation or through National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT) or Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS) payment mode, a Rebate of 1.5% shall be allowed on the Monthly Transmission Charge Invoice or Supplementary Bill for payments made within a period of 5 days of presentation of invoice/bill; or Explanation: In case of computation of '5 days', the number of days shall be counted consecutively without considering any holiday. However, in case the last day or 5th day is an official holiday, the 5th day for the purpose of rebate shall be construed as the immediate succeeding working day (as per the official State Government's calendar, where the Office of the Authorised Signatory or Representative of the Beneficiary, for the purpose of receipt or acknowledgement of Bill is situated).
6.	Article 10.3.1 (b) of TSA	For payment of Invoices subsequently, but within the Due Date, a Rebate of 1% shall be allowed on the payments made in full.	Where payments are made on any day after 5 days and within a period of 30 days of presentation of invoices/bills, a rebate of 1% shall be allowed.
